

Want to use someone else's work? Follow these 4 simple copyright rules

Is the use non-commercial?

You're not allowed to sell anything that uses someone else's work.



Is your use of their work fair?

You can take a little bit, but not too much—a small piece is fine, but taking huge chunks isn't really fair.

Is it for educational use only?

It needs to be part of *your* schoolwork—you shouldn't use it anywhere else.



Do you give credit to the creator?

You should always reference the original creator of the work.
