Books, magazines and digital resources are protected by copyright, but CLA's licence to copy lets you copy from publications your institution owns

The licence gives you...



5%

permission to copy 1 article, 1 chapter or 5% - whichever is the greater - from a published book, magazine or journal



peace of mind that you are not infringing copyright, because the licence gives you blanket permission to copy from works opted in



time - and financial - savings because you don't have to seek permissions directly from publishers



the knowledge that creators will be fairly paid for the use of their work. Once CLA's operating costs are deducted, your licence fees are paid to publishers, authors and visual artists
